

Meta-Assessment Committee Charge

The Meta-Assessment Committee (MAC) is established by the Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor to help support, evaluate and improve assessment practices for both undergraduate and graduate programs at UCR. The MAC is responsible for reviewing and improving program learning outcomes assessment templates to ensure their effectiveness and alignment with WASC standards, reviewing and improving assessment rubrics, using assessment rubrics to evaluate program learning outcomes reports, and providing feedback to programs, colleges and the campus. The MAC also leads workshops to help improve the effectiveness of both undergraduate and graduate program learning outcome assessment.

The membership of the Meta-Assessment Committee is designed to be inclusive of a wide-range of methodological assessment expertise from faculty across campus. The MAC is co-chaired by the Director of Evaluation and Assessment and by a faculty member with assessment expertise. The co-chairs of this committee and one additional member will serve as representatives on the Assessment Advisory Council, a group responsible for monitoring accreditation activities and assessment across campus and providing recommendations to the Provost for campus improvement.
